This document describes the features of Parallels Pro Control Panel 10.3.2 for Windows 2003 (formerly known as Ensim Pro for Windows 2003).

Parallels Pro Control Panel is a robust control panel solution for small and large professional hosting providers. Parallels Pro Control Panel includes all the tools and features that you, as a hosting provider need, in order to build compelling, commercial-quality plans for shared and reseller hosting.

With Parallels Pro Control Panel, you can:

- Define targeted, compelling site templates for shared site and reseller hosting. By defining a site template once, you can establish new customers quickly, while controlling application settings and resource quotas.
- Customize the look and feel of the control panel to suit your branding preferences.
- Review detailed reports of bandwidth and disk usage per site and allow accurate and complete billing of all traffic used by sites.
- Protect shared sites with a virtual private file system and provide additional site security.
- Delegate administration to your customers, including your resellers, site owners, and site users, while simultaneously reducing your support calls and improving customer satisfaction.

# Parallels Pro Control Panel 10.3.2 Specifications

- **ASP.NET 2.0 framework:** Parallels Pro Control Panel software is built on the ASP.NET 2.0 framework.
- **Support for WoW64:** Parallels Pro Control Panel now supports WoW64 emulation mode on Windows 2003 64-bit operating system server.
- **Support for new versions of Power tools:** Parallels Pro Control Panel supports the new versions of Community Server 2.1 and DotNetNuke 4.4.1.
- **Web Services APIs:** Parallels Pro Control Panel 10.3.2 supports Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) for Web Hosting services. Web Services APIs automate common tasks across all service levels such as provisioning resellers, sites and users, and managing services.

# Server Administrators

View the usage count (that is, the number of named-based sites using an IP address).</li> <li>▪ View/Edit the site data path on the Parallels Pro Control Panel server where site-related data is stored.</li> </ul>

Site Templates	Enables Server Administrators to use site templates for fast and efficient provisioning of sites. Site templates are templates that provide a common configuration base for provisioning sites with common services and settings.
Site security	Enables Server Administrators to set appropriate Windows security levels for each site.
Reseller management	Enables Server Administrators to Add/Update/Remove/Enable/Disable resellers accounts and update or remove reseller sites.

Updates utility	<p>Enables Server Administrators to set preferences for auto-update facility in order to automatically download available updates via Parallels Pro Control Panel Update Server on the Parallels Pro Control Panel server.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ If the Server Administrator enables the auto-update facility, a Windows scheduler downloads the available updates on the Parallels Pro Control Panel server at a time specified by the Server Administrator.</li> <li>▪ If the Server Administrator does not enable the auto-update facility, then the Server Administrator must check for new updates by clicking the <i>Product Updates</i> link on the Parallels Pro Control Panel. Each critical update in the list is displayed with a critical icon next to it. The Server Administrator must first install such updates. All the updates are listed in descending order of priority such that when you select a update, all the updates listed under the selected update, which require to be downloaded and/or installed are also selected for download and/or installation.</li> </ul>
Usage reports	<p>Enables Server Administrators to view the following usage reports:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Bandwidth usage report.</b> Displays consolidated as well as individual usage reports for resellers and sites.</li> <li>▪ <b>Disk usage report.</b> Displays disk usage summary for all sites. The reports can be emailed or downloaded to a local system.</li> </ul>

## Reseller Administrators

Reseller features are the same as Server Administrator features except that resellers cannot:

- Add/Revoke resources
- Perform operating system level tasks such as starting and stopping services
- Set preferences for the Updates utility to automatically download available updates or manually check for available updates from the Parallels Pro Control Panel Updates Server

**Note:** Unlike server administrators, the resellers can retrieve their forgotten passwords while logging into the Parallels Pro Control Panel. To be able to retrieve the password, the resellers must set password security information the first time while logging into the Parallels Pro Control Panel. By providing the correct password security information, resellers are then able to retrieve the lost password.
