Introduction

This document describes the features of Ensim®Pro 10.3.0 for Windows 2003.

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About Ensim Pro

Ensim Pro is a robust control panel solution for small and large professional hosting providers. Ensim Pro includes all the tools and features that you, as a hosting provider need, in order to build compelling, commercial-quality plans for shared and reseller hosting.

With Ensim Pro, you can:

- Define targeted, compelling site templates for shared site and reseller hosting. By defining a site template once, you can establish new customers quickly, while controlling application settings and resource quotas.
- Customize the look and feel of the control panel to suit your branding preferences.
- Review detailed reports of bandwidth and disk usage per site and allow accurate and complete billing of all traffic used by sites.
- Protect shared sites with a virtual private file system and provide additional site security.
- Delegate administration to your customers, including your resellers, site owners, and site users, while simultaneously reducing your support calls and improving customer satisfaction.

Ensim Pro 10.3.0 specifications

- **ASP.NET 2.0 framework:** Ensim Pro software is built on the ASP.NET 2.0 framework.



- **Support for WoW64:** Ensim Pro now supports WoW64 emulation mode on Windows 2003 64-bit operating system server.
- **Support for new versions of Power tools:** Ensim Pro supports the new versions of Community Server 2.1 and DotNetNuke 4.4.1.
- **Web Services APIs:** Ensim Pro 10.3.0 supports Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) for Web Hosting services. Web Services APIs automate common tasks across all service levels such as provisioning resellers, sites and users, and managing services.

Note: The Web Services APIs support **only** the tasks that can be executed through the CLI (Command Line Interface) calls.

Following are the product features for each administrative level.

Server Administrators

Table 1. Server Administrator features

Feature/item	Description
1 Server Management	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Restart the server.• Register, update, or renew the license.• Update the Server Administrator account information.• Customize customer control panels to include branding information. Server Administrators can create custom logos, banners, colors, graphics, and styles in their customer control panels.• View the network settings configured during installation.• View the current disk usage summary.• View/Add the IP addresses for the named-based sites in the system. View the usage count (that is, the number of named-based sites using an IP address).• View/Edit the site data path on the Ensim Pro server where site-related data is stored.
2 DNS management	Enables Server Administrators to configure and manage the following DNS settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Modify the default SOA record.• Modify a zone-specific SOA record.• View the zone configuration file.• Add/Refresh/Remove zones from a name server.• Add/Update/Remove zone records. The following records are supported: NS, CNAME, Host (A), Host (AAAA), MX, PTR, TXT, and SRV.

3 FTP server configuration	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• View FTP server settings.• Update FTP server settings.
4 Mail server configuration	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• View mail server settings.• Update mail server settings.• Send email notifications to resellers and Site Administrators.• Configure spam filter settings.
5 MySQL configuration	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Configure the number of MySQL databases for a site.
6 Microsoft SQL Server 2005 configuration	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Configure the number of Microsoft SQL Server 2005 databases for a site.• Configure database management for a site.
7 Database Tools	Enables Server Administrators to Add/Remove/View/Edit custom database tools for managing Microsoft SQL Server 2005 and/or MySQL databases.
8 Site management	Enables Server Administrators to Add/Remove/Enable/Disable a site.

9 Service provisioning	Enables Server Administrators to Enable/Disable the following services for a site: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• DNS• Domain aliases• Webalizer log analyzer• Microsoft IIS Web server• Microsoft FrontPage Server Extensions• Active Perl• Secure Web (SSL)• Server Side Includes (SSI)• Web Logs• Subdomains• Export / Import• File Manager• Web-based email• Spam Filtering• Vacation Auto-responder• FTP• MySQL• Microsoft SQL Server 2005• Power Tools
10 Site Templates	Enables Server Administrators to use site templates for fast and efficient provisioning of sites. Site templates are templates that provide a common configuration base for provisioning sites with common services and settings.
11 Site security	Enables Server Administrators to set appropriate Windows security levels for each site.
12 Reseller management	Enables Server Administrators to Add/Update/Remove/Enable/Disable resellers accounts and update or remove reseller sites.
13 Autologin	Enables Server Administrators to automatically log in to the reseller and Site Administrator control panel to perform administrative tasks.
14 Create and manage skins	Enables Server Administrators to Add/Remove/Apply/Update/Change skins as well as preview a skin and set a skin as the default skin for the Ensim control panel.

Feature/item	Description
15 Usage reports	Enables Server Administrators to view the following usage reports: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bandwidth usage report. Displays consolidated as well as individual usage reports for resellers and sites.• Disk usage report. Displays disk usage summary for all sites. The reports can be emailed or downloaded to a local system.
16 Export/Import	Enables Server Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Export/Import the data with the following settings:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Site<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Config Only. This option is for exporting or importing only the configuration settings (and not the associated data) of the site.○ Config and Data. This option is for exporting or importing the configuration settings and all the service-specific data of the site.▪ User<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ All Users. This option is for exporting or importing the information of all the users configured for the site.○ Admin Only. This option is for exporting or importing the information of only the default site administrator of the site.
17 Log file archiving	Enables Server Administrators to either archive log files as per the specified archive schedule, or delete log files from the Site Administrator's Web server in order to free up disk space on the Web server.
18 Switch asp.net version for site admins	Enables Site Administrators to switch to Microsoft .NET 2.0 version in order to run .NET 2.0 applications.
19 IDN (Internationalized Domain Name)	Enables representation of domain names and email addresses using non-ASCII characters.
20 SSL	Enables Server Administrators to secure sites using SSL certificates.
21 Power Tools	Enables Server Administrators to install and configure a number of popular Web applications that provide e-commerce, content management, forums, chat, and other dynamic features of Web sites.

Reseller Administrators

Reseller features are the same as Server Administrator features except that resellers cannot:



- Add/Revoke resources
- Perform operating system level tasks such as starting and stopping services

Note: Unlike server administrators, the resellers can retrieve their forgotten passwords while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. To be able to retrieve the password, the resellers must set password security information the first time while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. By providing the correct password security information, resellers are then able to retrieve the lost password.

Site Administrators

Table 2. Site Administrator features

Feature/item	Description
1 User management	Enables Site Administrators to Add/Update/Remove user accounts.
2 Manage files and directories	Enables Site Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create/Rename/Remove directories and files • Copy and move files and directories • Change file and directory permissions • View file and directory properties
3 Protect directories	Enables Site Administrators to protect directories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using the Microsoft FrontPage Extensions interface. Site Administrators can connect to the FrontPage and manage files and directories. • Using the Site Administrator control panel. If Microsoft FrontPage Extensions is not enabled, they can password-protect directories using the Site Administrator control panel.
4 Microsoft .NET version	Enables Site Administrators to switch Microsoft .NET version to 2.0 in order to run .NET 2.0 applications. <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>Note: In order for the Site Administrator to be able to switch to Microsoft .NET version 2.0, the Server Administrator must enable the option <code>switch asp.net version for site admins</code></p> </div>
5 MySQL	Enables Site Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create multiple MySQL databases • View/Update/Delete databases • Rename databases • Change the MySQL password • Manage databases by connecting to a database tool interface such as phpMyAdmin from the Site Administrator control panel

6 Microsoft SQL Server 2005	Enables Site Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create multiple Microsoft SQL Server 2005 databases• View/Update/Delete databases• Rename databases• Change the Microsoft SQL Server 2005 password• Manage databases by connecting to a database tool interface such as Web Data Administrator from the Site Administrator control panel
7 Power Tools	Enables Site Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Install tools on the site• Update tool settings• Upgrade installed tools• Change the owner of an installed tool• Remove installations of tools
8 Service management	Enables Site Administrators to configure the settings of the following services: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• MySQL• Microsoft SQL Server 2005 <div data-bbox="743 1098 1256 1392" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"><p>Note: Site Administrator can create and manage Microsoft SQL Server 2005 databases only if the Server Administrator has purchased the Microsoft SQL Server 2005 add-on license and has enabled the option enable database management for the site in the Server Administrator control panel.</p></div>
9 SSL	Enables Site Administrators to secure sites using SSL certificates.
10 Subdomains	Enables Site Administrators to Add/Update/Delete subdomains.
11 Log management	Enables Site Administrators to configure rotation settings for logs of the site.
12 Aliases	Enables Site Administrators to Add/Update/Remove aliases.
13 Responders	Enables Site Administrators to Add/Update/Remove responders.
14 Message forwarding	Enables Site Administrators to redirect or forward email messages to alternate addresses.
15 Spam management	Enables Site Administrators to manage spam by creating a Sendmail Reject List

16 Web-based email	Enables Site Administrators to manage email messages by connecting to a Web-based interface from the Site Administrator control panel.
17 IDN (Internationalized Domain Name)	Enables representation of domain names and email addresses using non-ASCII characters.
18 Autologin	Enables Site Administrators to automatically log in to the User Administrator control panel to perform administrative tasks.
19 Create and manage skins	Enables Site Administrators to Add/Remove/Apply/Update/Change skins as well as preview a skin and set a skin as the default skin for the Ensim control panel.
20 Retrieve user password	Enables Site Administrators to retrieve their forgotten passwords while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. To be able to retrieve the password, the Site Administrator must set password security information the first time while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. By providing the correct password security information, the Site Administrator is then able to retrieve the lost password.
21 Export/Import	Enables Site Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Export/Import the user data with the following settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Config Only. This option is for exporting or importing only the configuration settings (and not the associated data) of the user. ▪ Config and Data. This option is for exporting or importing the configuration settings and all the service-specific data of the user.
22 Log file archiving	Enables Site Administrators to configure log file archiving using the following options: <p>enable log file archiving. This option is to enable either archiving or deletion of log files from the Site Administrator's Web server.</p> <p>maximum number of archives. This is the maximum number of archives available per each archive schedule.</p> <p>archive when the log file size [mb] reaches. This is the log file size limit which qualifies a log file for an archive.</p>

1 Spam management	Enables User Administrators to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Configure spam options • Create Allowed Senders List • Create Blocked Senders List

2 Email aliases	Enables User Administrators to Add/Remove email aliases.
3 Responders	Enables User Administrators to Add/Update/Remove responders.
4 Vacation Messages	Enables User Administrators to Enable/Disable/Add/Update vacation messages.
5 Email forwarding	Enables User Administrators to configure alternate addresses to which email messages can be forwarded.
6 Subdomains	Enables User Administrators to view subdomain details and connect to a subdomain.
7 IDN (Internationalized Domain Name)	Enables representation of domain names and email addresses using non-ASCII characters.
8 Retrieve user password	Enables User Administrators to retrieve their forgotten passwords while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. To be able to retrieve the password, the User Administrator must set password security information the first time while logging into the Ensim Pro control panel. By providing the correct password security information, the User Administrator is then able to retrieve the lost password.
9 Apply/Preview skins	Enables User Administrators to apply skins (that is, set a skin as current) to the control panel as well as preview a skin .

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
